**Payment Plan for Extended Session**

Students are required to pay one-third of all semester charges **by the last day of regular registration for the current semester or term**. The remaining balance is required in two payments and the students will be assessed a \$25.00 payment plan fee. To meet the one-third requirement, students may apply the following:

- Sponsor Name
- Educational Expenses to be Covered by Sponsor.

The remaining semester balance may be paid in two installments. Failure to pay the entire balance of tuition and fees by the third payment date will result in a late fee of \$50.00. Also, failure to satisfy financial obligations to the University will result in having a restriction placed on future class registrations, possibly having the account assigned to a collection agency, and non-release of transcripts. A current semester or term debt must be paid in full before a student will be allowed to register during registration dates that occur prior to the third payment due date.

If students wish to use the payments from the sponsors in the calculation of the 1/3rd payment requirement, the University must receive the following

**Extended Session**—At least 1/3 of all tuition, fees, and charges are payable by the last day of regular registration or at the time of late registration. The remaining balance will be required in two payments. Failure to pay all charges by the third and final payment date will result in a late payment fee.

**Session A+B**—Payment is due in full no later than the first day of class. Failure to pay all charges by the payment due date will result in a late payment fee.

**Payment of Account Summary**

It is the responsibility of the students to pay their account balance by the established payment due dates.

All financial or other obligations to the University must be cleared prior to the end of each semester or term. An outstanding balance for a prior semester or term must be paid before the student will be allowed to register for subsequent semesters or terms. Failure to satisfy financial obligations to the University will result in having a restriction placed on future class registrations and tran-

scripts. Delinquent student accounts may be reported to a credit bureau and referred to collection agencies or ligated. ## Online Registration Procedures

1. In consultation with your academic adviser, plan your schedule carefully. Always identify (with your adviser) alternate courses in the event that some courses may be unavailable to you when you access the registration module. SPECIAL NOTE: You will not be able to access the registration module if you have not met with your academic adviser or are a first semester Troy student.
2. Go to <http://www.troy.edu> and click on Trojan Web Express. Click on Continue to Trojan Web Express (located in the left column of the screen) wait three seconds, and menu appears.
3. Click on the "Log In" button at the top right of the screen. Determine your user name by clicking on "What's My User ID?" Initial Password: First initial of your first name capitalized, first initial of your last name lower case and your date of birth. (Ex: Tu06251994) Immediately after logging in you will be prompted to change your password. The new Password must be between 7 and 25 characters. It must contain at least one number, one uppercase letter, and one lowercase letter. Your new password cannot contain your first name, middle name, last name, or username.
4. **Note: Military Affiliations** Click on "Military Affiliations," fill out the form, and click submit.
5. Click on "Student Self-Service."
6. Click on "Student Planning."
7. Click on "Course Catalog."
8. Search for course by subject. You must type the department (e.g. Mathematics, not MTH).
9. Find your section number by using the drop down arrow on the red bar. Note you can filter the information by location, term/semester, etc. by using the panel on the left side of the screen.
10. Click Add Section to schedule.
11. Repeat steps 7 through 10 for each course you would like to register for. You can also add courses to your plan by clicking directly on the course number from the My Progress page. This will direct you to the specific course in the course catalog.
12. Once all courses are planned, click plan and schedule. Use the arrows to navigate to the correct term or semester.
13. Once you have verified all courses and sections are correct, click Register Now in the upper right hand corner of the screen.
14. Click the OK button to accept the terms.
15. All courses should turn green. If any remain yellow, please contact your advisor or the Registrar's Office to help you determine why the course(s) didn't go through.
16. You may print your schedule by clicking the Print button located on the schedule tab.

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### FINANCIAL AID NOTE:

**Only courses required for your degree will be eligible for FA/VA. If any course is not properly assigned on your EVAL, request an official program evaluation at <https://forms.troy.edu/forms/academic/index.html>**

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Students may drop a course through Student Planning or their departmental registration site on Tuesday, May 31, 2016, without additional charges. However, a fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) will be assessed for each course dropped after this date, and students remain responsible for payment of all tuition and fees. Students may **NOT** add a course after 4:00 p.m. in person or on Student Planning after Tuesday, May 31, 2016.

**CAUTION:** Students who receive financial assistance should check the Catalog and/or

satisfactory progress policy at [www.troy.edu/financialaid](http://www.troy.edu/financialaid) PRIOR TO dropping below the credit hour requirement for full-time status. Dropping below full-time status could adversely affect financial aid award and future eligibility.

Any student whose scholarship or financial aid requires full-time status will be billed for the full amount of tuition and fees if he or she fails to maintain full-time status.

If you need a paper FAFSA, you may obtain one by calling 800-4-FED-AID or 800-433-3243.

If you have already applied for current year financial aid, the USDE will send a reminder in November/December to all renewal eligible applicants with a valid e-mail address. If e-mail is undeliverable, a paper reminder letter will be sent. Students without a valid e-mail address will receive paper reminders rather than pin mailers.

If the student has not reapplied by **February 1st**, the USDE will send follow up e-mail reminders or paper mail reminders as appropriate.

Students **MUST APPLY AS EARLY AS ALLOWABLE** for financial aid in order to avoid difficulties. **March 1** is the application priority date. Moreover, students **MUST CAREFULLY CHECK** the accuracy of their applications to avoid unnecessary delays and other complications.

**Note to Borrowers:** If you borrowed at Troy University and drop a course or withdraw from the University, you should go to [www.troy.edu/financialaid](http://www.troy.edu/financialaid) to complete an exit interview and to notify your lender that you are no longer enrolled or enrolled in less than half time. Repayment begins in 6 months. There are deferments of payment for unemployment, hardship, etc.; see Financial Aid Adviser.

Students who do not attend any classes will forfeit their financial aid. Students who are reported as not attending a class for which they are registered will receive a non-attendance letter/form requiring an instructor's signature or financial aid could be reversed, forfeiting the aid. The student will also be required to pay all tuition and fees. Withdrawal from the University will also require repayment of unused portions of federal assistance.

### Financial Aid

All students who receive Title IV funds (Pell Grant, FSEOG, and Loans) **ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND THOSE CLASSES FOR WHICH THEY REGISTER**. Attendance will be verified by the class instructors. Students who do not attend any classes will forfeit their financial aid. Students who are reported as not attending a class for which they are registered will receive

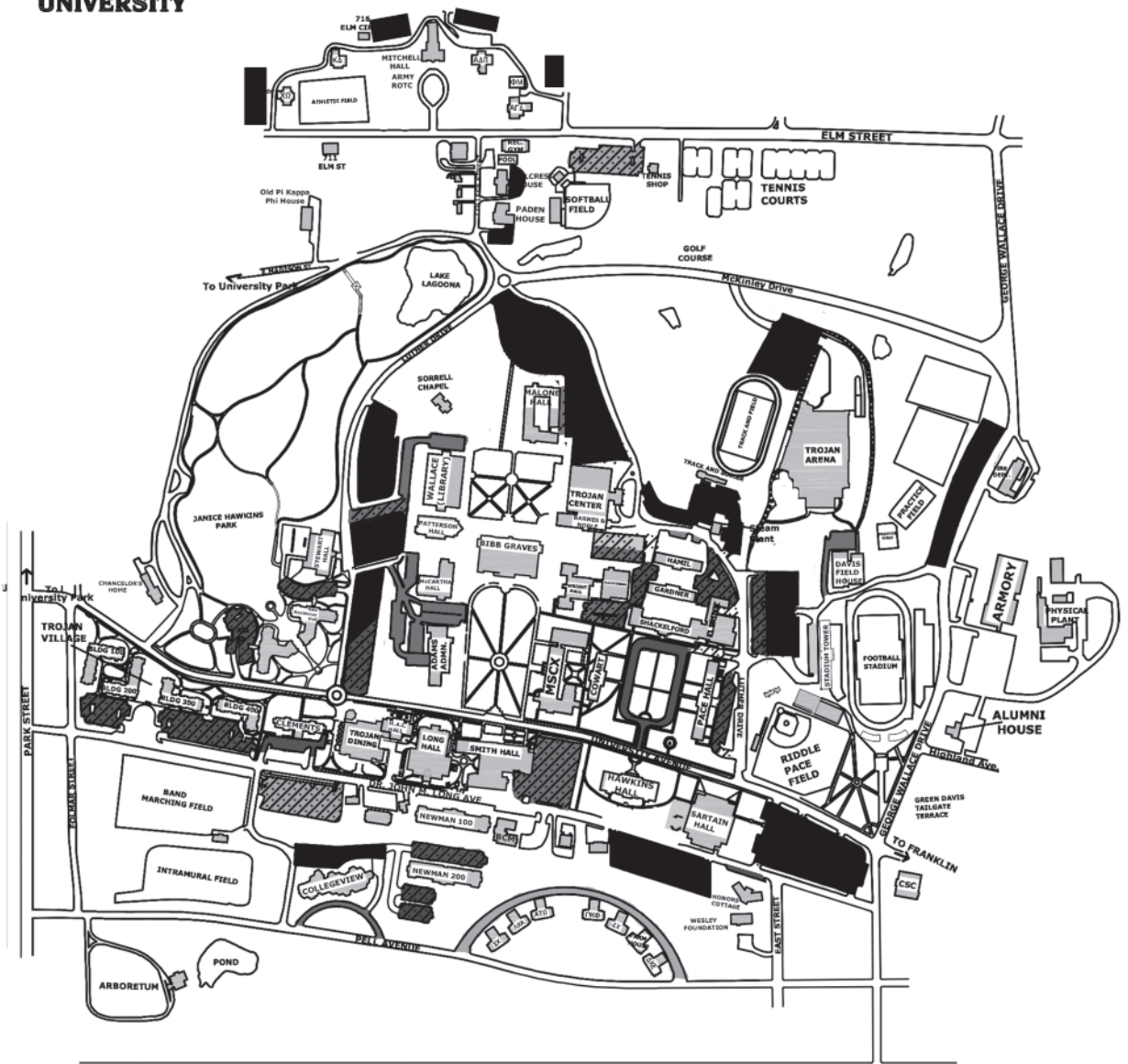
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**Campus Map**

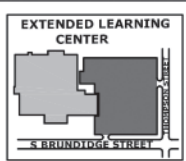
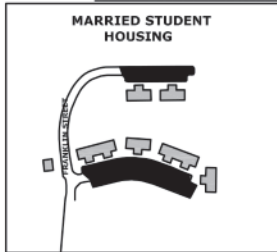


# TROY UNIVERSITY PARKING MAP

### Additional Examination Notes

- Final Examinations in graduate courses will be scheduled at the discretion of the faculty, as approved by the Dean of the College or School.
- Requests for changing the examination schedule will be denied unless a student presents bonafide documentation that the

student has a conflict because he or she is representing the University in an official capacity, is fulfilling a military obligation, is undergoing medical treatment, or is being restricted by virtue of conditions beyond his or her control.

### Veterans and Students with Disability

### Proficiency Profile Exam

As part of TROY's ongoing institutional assessment initiative, the Proficiency Profile assessment is required of a select group of undergraduate students. The assessment is instrumental in demonstrating program effectiveness for accreditation purposes. The results of the Proficiency Profile are beneficial to both the student and TROY.

Students who receive the Leadership, Chancellor, or Millennium scholarship and conditionally admitted students are required to complete the Proficiency Profile during their first semester as a freshman, and a fol-

low-up assessment is required upon acquiring junior classification.

Each student will receive an email explaining expectations and registration for the Proficiency Profile.

New students and undeclared majors who wish to declare a major field of study or students who wish to change majors should follow these simple steps:

- 1.** Report to the Department Chair's Office of the major you wish to select.
- 2.** Complete the Classification of Instructional Program form to make your selection official.
- 3.** Request that a faculty adviser in your new major be assigned to you.
- 4.** With your new adviser, carefully plan your semester schedule in accordance with the degree requirements stipulated in the Catalog under which you first enrolled, or agree to change to the current Catalog degree requirements.
- 5.** With your new adviser, carefully complete a Schedule Request.
- 6.** Have your new faculty adviser approve the Schedule Request and remove the Adviser's Hold.
- 7.** Sign the Schedule Request and present it to the terminal operator who will then enter the courses (or alternative courses, as necessary) and print your schedule and statement of fees.
- 8.** Request a revised official Graduation Check Sheet from the Records Office, which will require two to four weeks to prepare.

**To Declare a Major or To Change a Major**

Undergraduate students should be aware that summer tuition and fees are assessed at the prevailing hourly rate. The recommended maximum credit load for the entire summer (any combination of sessions) is twelve (12) semester hours, which is the minimum credit hours for full time financial

aid. The credit limit for Extended Session and/or Sessions A and/or B is twelve (12) semester hours for undergraduate students and 8-9 semester hours for graduate students. Exceptions to this limit require the approval of the Adviser and Department Chair.

**Credit Load and Summer Tuition**

Students who, for any reason, register for classes but do not attend MUST NOTIFY THE RECORDS OFFICE IN WRITING TO WITHDRAW, PRIOR TO THE FIRST CLASS MEETING. **Any student who fails to do so will be responsible for payment of fees and will be charged with failing grades.**

courses for a current term/semester may withdraw with no academic penalty with a non-punitive grade of "W" up until the last day to drop without Academic Penalty Period (posted in the Schedule of Classes and on appropriate web pages).

**Withdrawal**

Students who withdraw after the last day of registration must complete and process the Official Withdrawal Form to protect their records. (Refer to the current Catalog for refund policy.) This form is available in the Student Development Office, Eldridge Hall 102. Exit Interviews are required for all withdrawals.

Students may not withdraw from a term/session/semester online. An official withdrawal form must be completed and processed before the student's withdrawal is considered final. **Students may not withdraw after the withdrawal deadline.** Any student who fails to do so will be held responsible for payment of tuition as well as fees and will be assigned a grade. Extenuating circumstances must be properly documented.

#### **Withdrawals for Students Receiving Title IV Aid**

## Student Refunds/ Higher One

To receive any refunds from the University, a student must activate his or her refund preference with Higher One.

First check the mail for your Refund Selection Kit, arriving in a bright green envelope. This will be sent to the address that you have on file with the University. Once it arrives, simply follow these steps to make your refund preference selection:

1. **Visit TrojanOneCard.com**
2. **Enter your Personal code** (Found in your Refund Selection kit)

### 3. **Select how you'd like to receive your money.**

Your options for receiving your refunds are:

- **Deposit to Another Account (ACH Transfer)**—Money in two to three business days, once released by the University to Higher One.
- **Higher One OneAccount**—Money deposited to the account the same business day funds are released by the University to Higher One.

## Higher One FAQS

### **What kinds of money might I receive from Troy?**

The most common type of money Higher One disburses to students are funds left over from financial aid awards, loans, or grants after tuition has been paid. Other types of money may include reimbursement for tuition overpayment or a dropped class.

### **Why am I getting a Personal Code?**

You will use your Personal Code to make your refund selection at TrojanOneCard.com.

### **How will I get a Personal Code?**

You will receive your personal Code in the mail at your primary address on file with TROY. Just look for the bright green envelope and please make sure your address is up-to-date.

### **How is my money delivered?**

Delivery of refund money is a multi-step process. First, TROY draws funds from the respective loan and/or grant provider and applies it to your student account. Once this information is verified, it is sent to Higher One. Once the specific refund information is received, it is processed and disbursed according to your selection.

### **Can I change my preference for receiving money from TROY?**

Yes. Just log into TrojanOneCard.com and select "Refund Preferences" from the "Refund" menu option. Once on the page, simply make your new selection and click "Update Preference" button to complete the

process. Be aware that your selection will only impact future money you receive from TROY.

### **How will I know when my money has been sent?**

Higher One will send you an email to the address you entered during setup. You can also view the status online at TrojanOneCard.com.

### **Will I automatically get sent a Higher One OneAccount debit card?**

No. When you make your refund preference selection and choose the OneAccount, a debit MasterCard will be sent to you and linked to your OneAccount.

### **What is the OneAccount?**

The OneAccount is a non-interest bearing, internet-only checking account, serviced by Higher One, Inc. It's exclusively designed for college students with features that support a mobile lifestyle, equipped with security features like cash deposit limits and cash withdrawal limits, offering money available the same day it's released by your school.

If you choose to open a OneAccount, it is important to note that the Trojan OneCard Debit MasterCard is not a credit card but rather a Debit MasterCard linked to your OneAccount.
