Financial Aid

How to Apply for Financial Aid?

- Create an FSA ID at <https://fsaid.ed.gov>.
- Go to FAFSA on the Web at studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa to apply for financial aid.
- Be sure you are applying for the correct year using school code 001047.
- Just fill in the blanks when prompted.
- It is recommended that you use the Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) to access your federal tax documents and have the financial information loaded directly from the IRS website. It can aid significantly in the reduction of errors.
- Your application reaches the federal processor immediately.

All students must fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year for the academic year covering their enrollment periods. Financial aid is NEVER renewed automatically.

An electronic copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) is made available to the schools you have listed on your FAFSA. Troy will not process this information unless you are an admitted degree seeking student.

Once we receive your SAR, we will verify the information and may ask for additional documentation/information depending on whether you were selected for verification by the Student Aid Processing Center. Please check your TROY email account regularly for any requests for additional information and documentation.

Once your application is processed, you are notified via email that an Award Letter has been issued. To view and accept the Award Letter, go to my.troy.edu, click on Self-Service, then on Financial Aid to access and accept the Award Letter.

Veterans Affairs

You can submit an Application for VA Educational Benefits on the DoVA website at <https://benefits.va.gov/gibill/> except if you are using VA 31 (VRE or VocRehab) or VA 1606. Once your application is processed by VA, you are issued a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) outlining your benefits. A copy of the COE should be provided to us for our records.

After you are enrolled in courses, you must complete and submit our VA Certification Request Form at <https://troy.elluciancloud.com/systu849/en/ellucianux/4562370015b27c8295d8104067781244/7890719085b461488e71172033936281.php>

Please note, this form must be completed every single term after you are enrolled in courses. The form is routed electronically to a VA Certifying Official who will certify your enrollment to VA. Be sure to check all locations where you are taking courses. For instance, if you are taking online courses and local in-class courses, check both locations on the form to ensure that all courses are certified properly to VA.

For VA 30 and VA 1606 you must also complete a monthly attendance verification either on the GI Bill website at <https://benefits.va.gov/gibill/> or by calling 877-823-2378 to receive your monthly, prorated amount. The monthly attendance verification may also become a requirement for VA 33 shortly.

Student Financial Services

Student Accounts

Students are responsible for all tuition and fees regardless of their source of assistance. If financial aid is approved, it is applied to student accounts after late registration ends each term. Any balance not covered by financial aid, tuition assistance, employer benefits, scholarships, VA benefits, or similar, is the student's responsibility.

Students who register for courses and do not officially drop/withdraw from the university are held responsible for all tuition and fees. Non-attendance is not considered an official drop/withdraw.

Payments

Payment of fees may be made online with Trojan Web Express or at Student Financial Services. Troy University accepts Visa, Master Card, Discover, American Express, money orders, checks, and cash.

Term payment due dates fall on the fourth Friday of the term. Student accounts with a remaining balance after the payment due date are charged a \$50 late fee. Failure to satisfy financial obligations to the University will result in having a restriction placed on future class registrations, possibly having the account assigned to a collection agency, and non-release of transcripts and diploma. Also note, a current semester or term debt must be paid-in-full before a student will be allowed to register during registration dates that occur prior to the payment due date.

Refunds

To receive your refund from Troy, you must activate your refund preference with BankMobile. A BankMobile personal code will be issued to your mailing address or your TROY email account. Once it arrives, simply follow these steps to make your refund preference selection:

1. Visit Refundselection.com
2. Enter your personal code
3. Select how you want your money delivered

Your options for receiving your refunds are:

Deposit to an existing account

Money is transferred to an existing account the same business day BankMobile receives funds from Troy. Typically, it takes 1-2 business days for the receiving bank to credit the money to your account.

Deposit to a BankMobile Vibe Checking Account

If you open a BankMobile Vibe checking account (upon identity verification), money is deposited the same business day BankMobile receives funds from Troy.

Past Due Accounts

All financial or other obligations to the University must be cleared prior to the end of each semester or term. An outstanding balance for a prior semester or term must be paid before the student will be allowed to register for subsequent semesters or terms. Failure to satisfy financial obligations to the University will result in having a restriction placed on future class registrations, transcripts, and/or diploma.

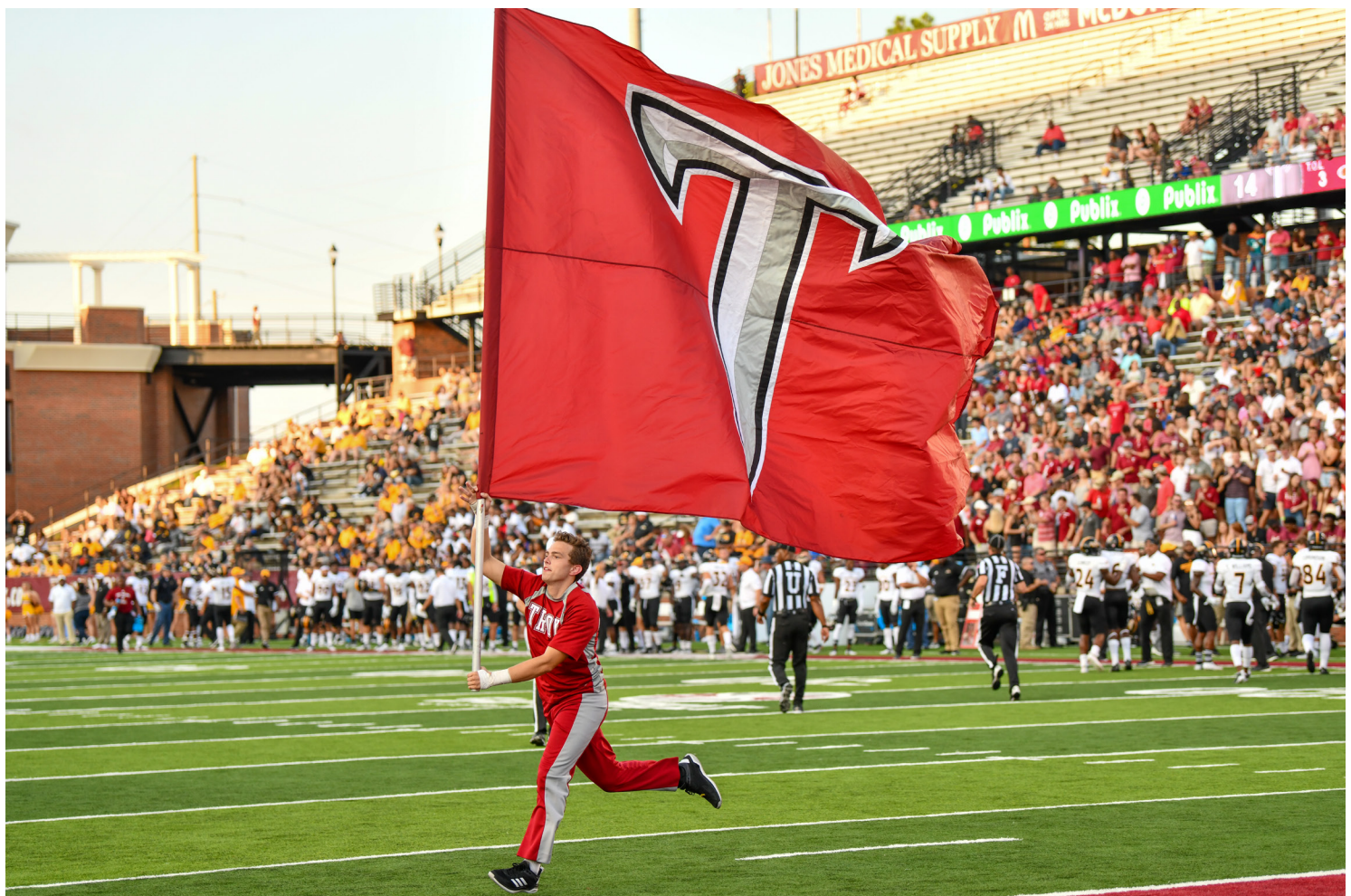
Delinquent student accounts may be reported to a credit bureau and referred to collection agencies or litigated. Students will agree to pay any and all costs associated with collection of unpaid fees including any/all collection agency fees (33.33%), attorney fees, and/or court costs, if such are necessary.

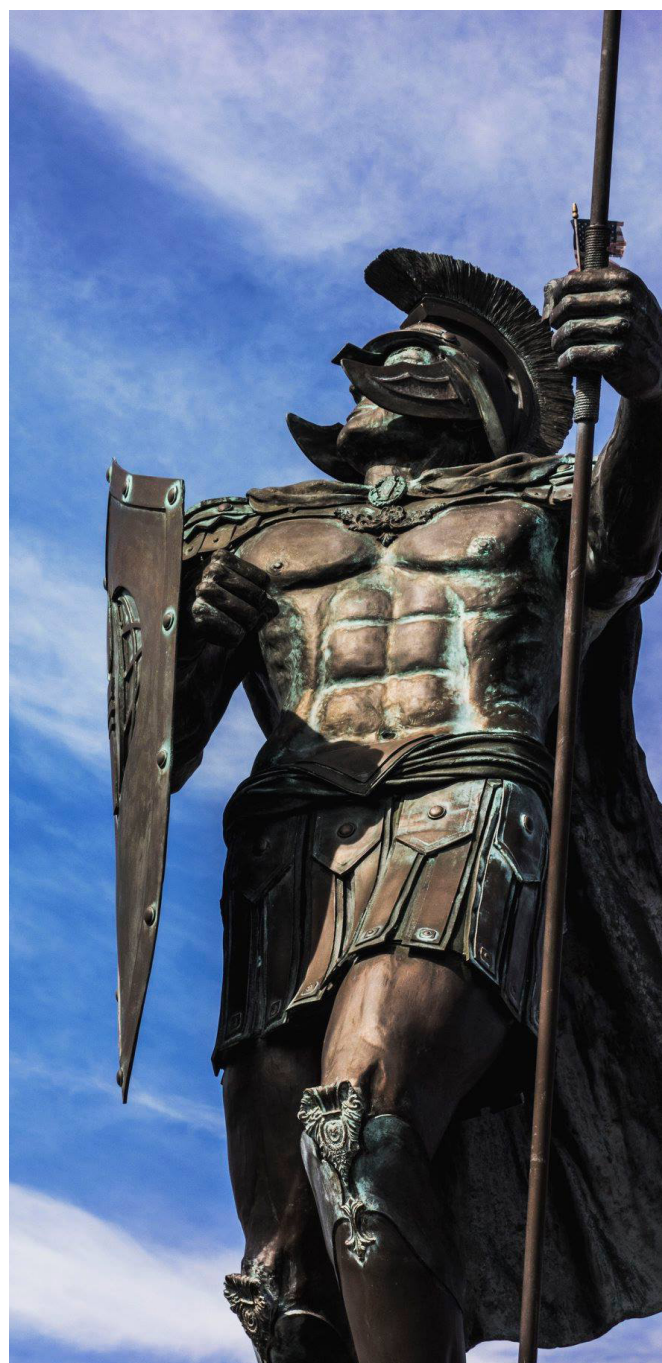

*Registration (online and on-campus) continues until the last day to drop/add for the Term or Semester

Registration Procedures:

1. Remove all holds which will prevent your registration (Business Office, Advisor Approval, etc).
2. In consultation with your academic advisor, plan your schedule and register for classes via Student Planning.
3. If you are unable to register through Student Planning please go to the Records Office, room 208, Whitley Hall. Nursing students go to the School of Nursing.
4. Check with the Student Financial Services/Financial Aid Office regarding your balance.

Visit the Admissions Office if you are a new student (not admitted), a returning student who has been out 1 or more years, a returning student who has attended another institution, or a returning student who has already graduated from Troy University.

Student Planning Registration

1. Navigate to my.troy.edu. If you already know your user ID and password, continue to "b."
 - a. Select Students and then click on "What's my TrojanPass ID?" Enter our last name and SSN or ID number, click submit, and write down our user ID.
 - b. Navigate to <https://login.microsoft.com>.
 - c. Enter your user ID + @troy.edu (for example, jdoe12345@troy.edu)
 - d. If you have already logged in before, enter our password. If you have not yet logged in, your initial password is as follows: first letter of your last name (lowercase), and your 8 digit birth date (mmddyyyy Ex. Ab01231999).
 - e. You must change your password and you will be prompted for additional information (alternate email address and security questions). Please follow the guidelines on the screen.
2. Once you have finished the login process, navigate to my.troy.edu.
3. Scroll down and click Self-Service on the 3rd row of boxes and then Student Planning.
4. Find "Search for courses..." at the top of the screen and type the first course for which you would like to register with no spaces (ex. MTH 1112).
5. Look for your course number (ex: MTH 1112), and then click Add Course to Plan. Select term or semester from the drop-down list, and click Add Course to Plan again.
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for each course for which you would like to register.
7. Click Student Planning at the top of the page and then click Plan & Schedule. Use the arrows (< >) to navigate to semester or term.
8. Click View other sections under your first course. Find a section that fits in your schedule, click on that yellow course block, and then click Add Section. There may be multiple pages of course section options. The section must be **YELLOW**, not **RED** (red courses are full/closed).
9. Repeat steps 7 and 8 for each course on your plan.
10. Click Register Now in the upper right corner of the screen. Click OK to accept the terms.
11. All courses should turn **GREEN** and you will have completed your registration. If any remain **yellow**, contact your advisor or the Records office.

Undergraduate Testing Services

The Proficiency Profile Test:

The Proficiency Profile Test can be administered in two and a half hours. The information is obtained to measure the students' academic skills in the general studies area. Associates take the test after completion of 48 hours and prior to graduation (exit exam), and bachelors 60-89 hours, during the junior year. Assessment results are used to fulfill a SACS requirement for accreditation and are important to ensure credibility of a diploma earned through Troy University.

Please include your name, student ID number, photo ID, and desired date and time in your email. Exams are held on the Riverfront Campus, room R301.

ACCUPLACER (Math & English Placement Test):

Undergraduate students who wish to enroll in Math or English courses must take the ACCUPLACER test prior to registering. Please go to my.troy.edu/online/testing/accuplacer-exam.html to register. Please allow 72 hours to process your request. *Photo ID is required.

Major Field Achievement Test (MFAT):

Business/Management & Criminal Justice

Any student seeking a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice or a Business Program MUST take the MFAT the term they register for their capstone course (BUS 3310, BUS 4476, and CJ 4499). Students will NOT be allowed to graduate if they do not take the MFAT. TROY Online students must register to take this exam by going to <https://my.troy.edu/online/testing/MFT-MAPP.html>. Testing dates are determined by the instructor. *Photo ID is required.

Comprehensive Exams

Students admitted into a graduate program requiring a comprehensive exam must pass the required exam prior to graduating. Students should consult Barbara Sanders at bsanders@troy.edu regarding procedures for scheduling and taking the comprehensive exam. This test is generally taken the last semester/term prior to graduation. If a student fails the comprehensive exam, they must successfully retake the exam within one year of the date originally taken. *Photo ID is required.

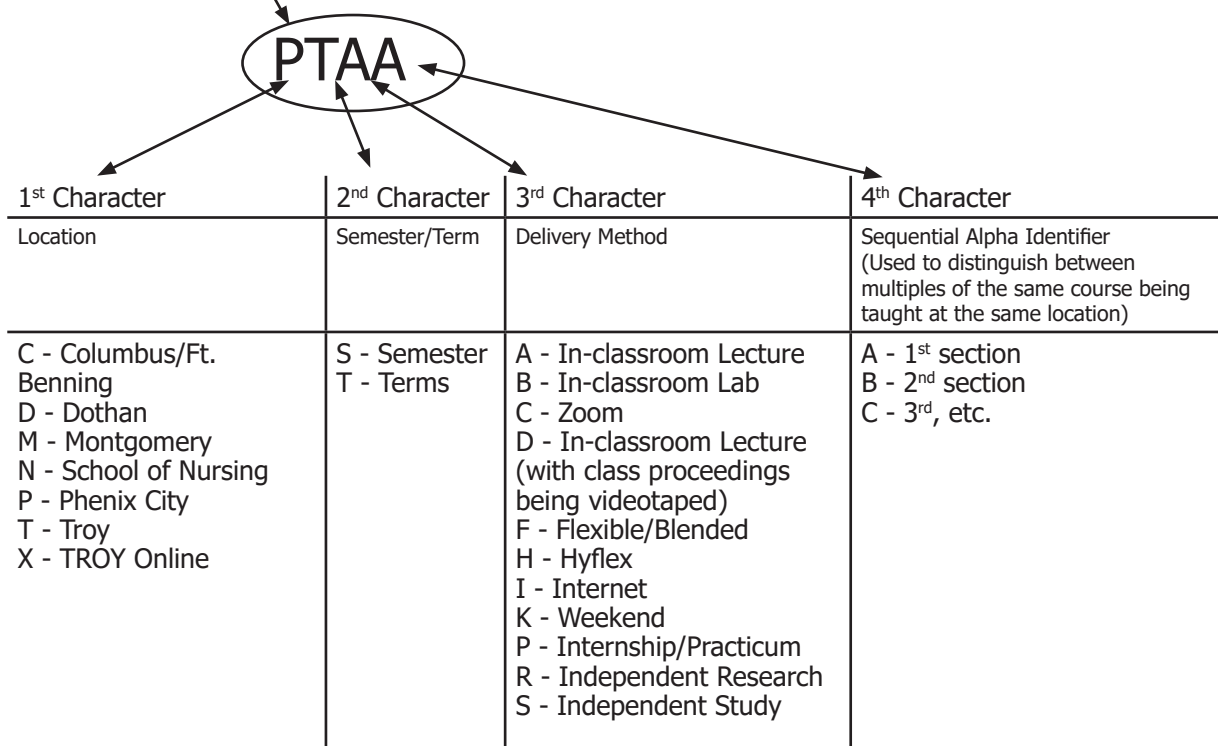
